

TIME Final Conference – Programme


TIME Final conference was held on 31st May and 1st June 2022 at the Mathematics Department of Faculty of Science in Zagreb, Croatia. It gathered more than 60 mathematics teachers from four partnering countries.




On the first day, there was a short presentation of all results of the project by the project leader Matija Bašić (from the Faculty of Science in Zagreb) and a TIMELess talk by Carl Winsløw (from the University of Copenhagen).



After the break, Sanja Antoliš (from XV. Gymnasium in Zagreb) and Željka Milin Šipuš (from the Faculty of Science in Zagreb) organized a discussion on the mathematical analysis of the Study Lesson.



The main topic of the Study Lesson was the algebraic characterization of perpendicular lines in the plane. After the discussion, Sanja has presented the scenario produced by the team from her school.





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The lesson has been organized in the library and there were 20 students. The teacher was Jelena Kos, from the team that planned the lesson. After the open lesson, all participants of the conference have discussed the lesson in the reflection session. The first day ended with the first two rounds of presentations of the teams.



The second day started with a TIME² talk by Rogier Bos (from the Utrecht University). It was followed by four more rounds of presentations of teams. There were 10 teams from seven schools: Midsjaelands Gymnasium, Utrecht Stedelijk Gymnasium, Goois Lyceum, Gimnazija Franca Miklošiča Ljutomer, Gimnazija Jesenice, V. Gymnasium and XV. Gymnasium. Each team prepared a small workshop, about 30 minutes long, in which they presented the scenario they have developed and implemented during the project.





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
